Chateau du Campuget Rose Costieres de Nimes 2018 - \$10.29 btl./\$53.25 1/2 case

"Campuget Rose's color is obtained through a short maceration between four and twelve hours, according to the varietal. Fermentation takes place in stainless-steel tanks with the temperature controlled at 18°C in order to extract the maximum aromas. After racking and filtration, the wine is immediately bottled at the Chateau."

Elk Cove Estate Pinot Noir Rose 2018 - \$14.99 btl./\$77.25 ½ case

"Pinot Noir fruit for our Rosé is hand-harvested very ripe and gently whole bunch pressed with limited skin crushing, which makes virtually a "white Pinot Noir". The wine is fermented cool in stainless steel tanks. Then carefully selected lots of fermented red Pinot Noir juice is blended back for color and texture. Our Pinot Noir Rosé is finished completely dry."

Mr. Pink Columbia Valley Rose 2018 - \$11.19 btl./\$62.50 ½ case

"Last year's cult rosé is back, and better than ever! Perfectly pink, with flavors full of fresh picked cherries, crisp watermelon and pomegranates, and lip smacking acidity to balance out the mouthwatering fruit."

Whispering Angel Cotes de Provence Rose 2018 - \$24.29 btl./\$130.00 ½ case

"Whispering Angel from Chateau d'Esclans is arguably the World's greatest Rosé. The grapes come from the most select land in the surrounding region of La Motte in Provence. The blend consists of Grenache, Cinsault, Rolle (Vermentino), Syrah and Tibouren. This rosé is crisp, fresh and elegant and comes highly recommended."

Stoller Pinot Noir Rose Willamette Valley 2018 - \$19.99 btl./\$109.00 ½ case

"Pinot Noir Rosé has been a cornerstone of our production for more than a decade. Comprised of various clones of Pinot Noir, we intentionally craft our Rosé to be balanced and bright. Whole cluster pressed and fermented in stainless steel, our 2018 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir Rosé shows alluring aromatics of strawberry and kiwi. "Pale and pretty in crystal-clear pink with orange undertones. The nose is delicate and fruity with notes of white peach and apricot mixed with passion fruit and mango. The taste is full, fresh and crisp with echoes of the fruity aroma amplified by citrus zest and sweet spices (cinnamon and cardamom)."

Triennes Mediterranean Rose 2018 - \$17.99 btl./\$89.00 ½ case

"This wine has a bouquet of strawberries and white flowers with hints of vanilla. It has the harmony and elegance that has earned world-wide appreciation of the rosés of Provence."

Bargemone Aix en Provence Rose 2018 - \$16.99 btl./\$90.00 ½ case

"Offers classic aromas of wild strawberries and red currants, with a light, floral character and a crisp, bone-dry palate. Bargemone is among the foremost estates of the Coteaux d'Aix appellation of Provence. A benchmark producer of the delicious, dry rosé for which Provence is famous, the Commanderie was founded by Templar knights in the 13th century."

Isenhower Cabernet Franc Rose Yakima Valley 2018 - \$13.49 btl./\$72.00 ½ case

"The Cabernet Franc Rosé is limpid with a light pale salmon hue. It has aromas and flavors of rhubarb, honeydew melon, rose petal, hibiscus, and pencil lead. The mouthfeel is a bone dry beauty with herbal melon notes, a generous midpalate yet with a feel of lightness."
